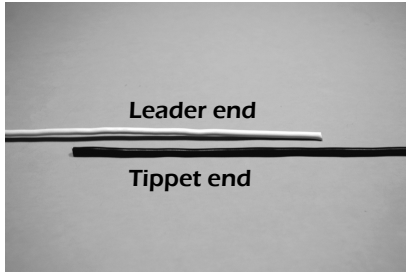
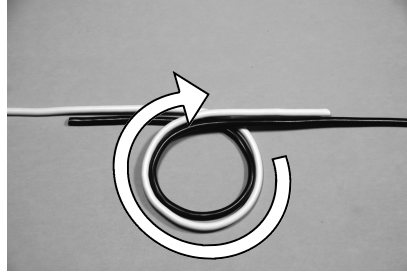


# BASIC FLYFISHING KNOTS

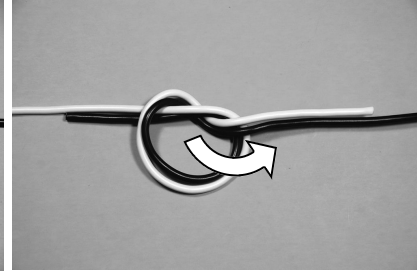
## Double Surgeons Knot



1) Lay the Leader and Tippet ends together in opposite directions, overlapping about 6–8 inches.



2) Take the end of the Leader and the end of the Tippet and with both together, make a full circle.



3) Pass both lines together through the inside of the circle forming an overhand knot.



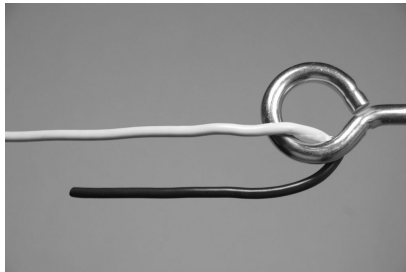
4) Pass both lines together through the inside of the circle once again to form a second wrap.



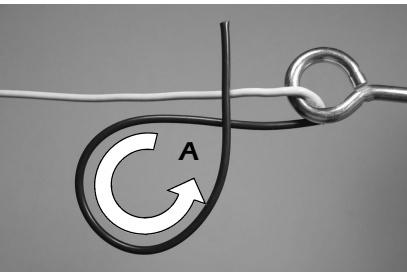
5) Moisten the knot, pull tight and trim the excess of both the Leader and Tippet Tag Ends.

*Use this knot to attach new tippet to your leader*

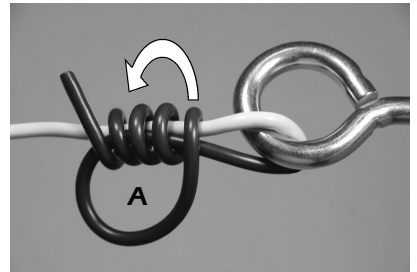
## Duncan Loop Knot



1) Thread the Tag End through the eye. Keep Tag End & Standing line together during the steps.



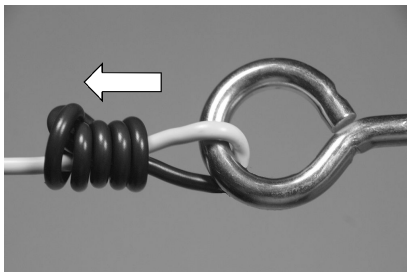
2) Bring the Tag End around in a full circle back toward the eye and form loop A.



3) Wrap the Tag end 4–5 turns through the inside of loop A.



4) Moisten the knot and pull it tight. Be sure the knot is fully tightened and then trim the excess



5) Pull the completed knot away from the eye opening up a small loop that the fly can move in.

*Use this knot to attach your tippet to your fly*
